The Respite Care Program

- Is a voluntary residential program for Summit county youth between the ages of 6 through 17 who are in need of short-term planned periods of respite.
- The primary focus of the program is to alleviate family stress through the provision of respite care services.
- During the respite period, youth are placed with House Parents who will assist with providing support for youth during their stay.
- House Parents are Trauma Informed professionals who are able to assist with individual skill development and provide emotional support.



Services offered during respite stay:

- Short-term Residential Care (Maximum length of stay per respite period is four days)
- Case Management
- Transportation to school and essential appointments
- Homework assistance
- Structured activities and outings
- Emotional support
- Individualized support

Referral procedures:

- Family members and community agencies may directly contact Shelter Care, Inc. for referrals.
- A referral questionnaire is completed with the caregiver or referring agency.
- Following the referral, an intake interview is scheduled.
