## ***What is Safe Landing?***

- *Safe Landing is a temporary, voluntary, emergency shelter providing help to youth and families in crisis.*
- *It is a safe alternative to the streets and provides an opportunity for hope and healing.*
- *Since 1978, over 15,000 youth have resided at Safe Landing.*
- *Annually, more than 2,500 youth and families have been provided counseling and supportive services.*
- *All services are free of charge to the youth and their families.*

## **Services Provided:**

- Short-term residential services for youth between the ages of 11 and 17
- 24-hour telephone hotline
- Individual and/or family counseling
- Case Management
- Drop-In Counseling
- Educational Support
- Aftercare Services

## **How Do You Get Help?**

Youth may come to the shelter by calling the crisis line or by dropping in.

A parent or concerned adult can also call about a young person.

An agency may refer a youth and their family in need of services.
